WHO KNOWS BEST?





Pray:

Lord, let everything I do in this season of Lent come from You, be inspired by You. I long to be closer to You. I long to receive the hope that You offer. Help me to remember that nothing is more important than You in my life Help me to rely on You for help.

I want to walk in your footsteps, Jesus.

I confess that I have often felt I knew better and ignored Your presence. Heal me, Lord, and help me to find You in the darkness of my life. Let me reach out and feel your hand and love there to guide me. Speak to me in this moment, Lord God. **Amen.**

Introduction:

When we 'delight in the Lord' the desires of our hearts become the things that make the Lord happy, like when a couple are newly in love or when a child wants to please their parents. It changes what we want from life from material things to things that connect us closely to the person we love. When we delight in someone the emphasis of what we want becomes the intense joy and freedom of feeling connected to another, to sharing one spirit and one mind. What we think and what we want becomes superseded by what the person we are 'delighting in' thinks and wants. There is no greater feeling of joy, peace and freedom than being at one with another person, and this is brought to completion when it is our God we are at one with.

When we are fully trusting in God, rejoicing in him, delighting in Him, and praising Him, there is an ease in hearing His voice and in choosing His ways rather than our own. When we are living close to Him, secure, strong and relishing in that closeness, it is as apparent to those around us as the first rays of the sun at dawn or as the brightness of the sun in the middle of the day. The fact that we are at one with God, cleared of all blame and right with Him will be obvious to all. Impossible to miss. Let's delight in our Lord today!

Psalm 119:1- I have in the past and now know Christians who I marvel at how they lived/live their lives and how they talk and interact with other people both non-believers and believers. I would love to be able to operate in a similar way and so I try to improve how I share my love of God by their examples as I continually walk with God on a daily basis.
